# SERVICE POSITIONS



## Booster Leadership

\*\*\*All Booster Leadership members are also required to serve as active members of the Fundraising Committee. The Booster Club as a whole is overseen by and accountable to the ETHS Board.

### *President*

Leads the Booster Club, oversees meetings, coordinates with the ETHS Board, and ensures that club goals and fundraising efforts are met.

### *Vice President*

Assists the President, fills in when needed, and supports overall operations and fundraising efforts.

### *Secretary*

Records and distributes meeting minutes, manages official communication, maintains club documentation, and assists with administrative needs.

### *Treasurer*

Manages Booster Club finances including tracking donations, expenses, and preparing financial reports. Coordinates closely with event leads to ensure accurate budgeting.

## Athlete Support + Recognition

### *Senior Night Coordinator*

Plans and oversees Senior Night celebrations for graduating athletes across all sports. May work with sport-specific volunteers to personalize events.

### *Letterman Jackets & Patches Coordinator*

Coordinates ordering, customization, and distribution of letterman jackets and earned patches for ETHS athletes.

### *College Sports Mentor & Signing Day Coordinator*

Supports ETHS student-athletes pursuing collegiate athletics by guiding them through the recruitment and application process. Responsibilities include advising on how to communicate with college coaches, building athletic résumés, preparing and sharing highlight videos, and understanding eligibility and scholarship opportunities. This mentor may host info sessions, offer one-on-one guidance as needed or find college alumni to mentor. Additionally, this role plans and coordinates Signing Day celebrations for ETHS athletes.

### *Alumni Game Coordinator*

Plans and organizes alumni athletic events. Coordinating with coaches and AD, recruiting alumni participants, managing event logistics, and promoting the event.

## Media + Exposure Team

### *Social Media Manager*

Manage all social media platforms to promote events, celebrate athletes, and engage the community. Create and post content regularly to maintain a strong, consistent brand.

### *Photographer*

Capture high-quality photos of games, practices, and events. Provide edited images for social media, print, and recruiting needs.

### *Videographer*

Film and edit videos for athlete highlight reels, recruiting tapes, promotional content and end of the year slide. Maintain a digital library of game footage and event coverage.

## Volunteer Operations & Game Day Coordination

### *Concessions & Volunteer Lead*

Oversees concession operations including purchasing, stocking, and reporting financials to the Board. Coordinates with Sport Volunteer Coordinators to ensure all positions are filled (e.g., gate, concessions, books, scoreboard, merch table, setup/cleanup).

### *Sport-Specific Volunteer Coordinators*

Each coordinator works directly with parents/guardians of athletes to fill required volunteer roles. SALC (Student Athlete Leadership Council) will only be contacted if positions remain unfilled.

## \*\*\*Fundraising + Event Committee

This committee plans and coordinates all organization-wide fundraising events and initiatives. Each member will take ownership of a specific project or role while collaborating as a team to accomplish *all events and fundraising goals*.

### Event and Project Leads:

#### Gala Coordinator

Organizes the annual gala fundraiser, including venue, catering, entertainment, decor, and logistics.

#### Golf Tournament Coordinator

Manages the annual golf tournament: booking the course, arranging lunch, coordinating prizes and rentals, and working with the team to recruit sponsors.

#### Pickleball Tournament Coordinator

Plans a family-friendly pickleball tournament, including venue, brackets, registration, and marketing.

#### End-of-Year Banquet Coordinator

Organizes the annual banquet including venue booking, catering, awards, decor, slideshow, and overall experience for athletes and families.

#### Meet the Chargers Coordinator

Plans the season kickoff event to pray over the season, introduce returning athletes, coaches, and the EHS Board, while building excitement and unity within the program. (Coaches in the dunk tank, corn hole tournament, watermelon, music, new merch table etc)

#### Individual Sport Fundraiser Coordinator

Works directly with coaches to coordinate smaller, team-specific fundraisers to meet immediate needs like new gear or tournament fees.

#### Advertising & Sponsorship Coordinator

Oversees ad sales for the website, programs, game banners, and sponsorships for events and teams.

#### Auction/Donation/Raffle Lead

Coordinates all raffle, silent auction, and donation-based activities, including soliciting items, organizing displays, and communicating with donors.

#### Merchandise Design & Sales Lead

Designs all EHS spirit wear and branded items (shirts, yard signs, car decals, seat cushions, cups, etc.). Coordinates pre-orders with teams and manages merchandise tables at events.
